During May 2019, an experienced player can mentor New Players and the experienced player plays for free! So all the experienced players can pass on their wisdom to the new folk. People can make their own arrangements, or contact the Club Manager if you seek a mentor or mentee.

Rules: "New Players" are "mentees" and they cannot be a Life Master. "Experienced players" are the "mentors" and they are players who have achieved the rank of Life Master. Regular pairs who play together at least once a month are not eligible for free plays. The Directors will keep a list of mentors who got free plays at the front desk during the month.

Mentors should provide help and advice during the game and maybe review a few hands after the game so that the mentee gets ideas on how to improve their game.
