- 1 Arrive 10 minutes before 7pm, This helps the Computer operator to set up.

- 3. Speed of play The Director usually states the allowed time to play a hand usually about 7 minutes/ board. Difficult hands are usually balanced with easier hands.

Constant slow play causes delays which can result in boards not being played and can penalise other players who were not at fault. Repeated infringements may result in the offending team being penalised.
