

MOTION TO AMEND THE PENYLAN CONSTITUTION

We, the undersigned, propose the following amendment to **Paragraph 10b ‘Admission to Membership’** of the Revised Penylan Constitution (dated 22/03/2022) that **currently** reads:

10 ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP

- b) The PMC may delegate the admission of new members to the Section Committees. These Committees must ensure that all applicants for membership complete the agreed application form and must be proposed and seconded by full members. Once approved by the Section Committee the name of the proposed member must be displayed on the notice board for seven days. The Section Secretary will then write to the member confirming their membership and collect the subscription.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

10 ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP

- b) The PMC may delegate the admission of new members to the Membership Secretary together with the Section Committees. The Membership Secretary must ensure that all applicants complete the agreed application form and are proposed and seconded by current members. The Membership Secretary will liaise with the appropriate Section Representative to obtain approval of the application. The Membership Secretary will email or write to the applicant advising the outcome of their application and collecting the subscription if the application has been approved. The date of the confirmation email or letter will be deemed to be the date of notice of election to membership. A minimum of 48 hours is required between application for membership and confirmation.

REASON FOR MOTION

To centralise the process for gaining information on new members and to clarify the definition of the notice of election date.
