Competition Secretary's Report January 2019

Dyer Smith Cup

We had 13 tables for the Dyer Smith. This was 4.5 down on last year but one more than 2016.

Fleming Femina / Hunter Homines

Entries currently stand at 13.5 tables for the Fleming Femina and 13.5 tables for the Hunter Homines. This is 4 tables more than this time last year for the ladies but the same as last year for the men's pairs. A reminder email has been sent and I am hoping for a few more tables. Last year we finished on 10.5 in the ladies (so are already up 3 tables) and 15.5 in the men's so just need another 4 more pairs to equal last year.

Arnold Cup

We have 18 teams in this year's competition. One more than last year which was three down on the year. As I said in my report last year I believe some teams have dropped out as they were always drawn against the same one or two teams. Due to ensuring first round matches are relatively local this is impossible to change due to the limited number of teams entering. The policy of ensuring everyone gets a reasonable local match could not be maintained this year with only Brian Crack's team entering from the east of the county.

Of the 18 teams, 2 were seeded and had byes in round 1 leaving a nice neat 16 teams to play against each other in round 1. The 8 losing teams have all gone into the Plate.

Corbett League

We have had repeat entries from all the clubs that participated last year. We also have an additional team from Bromley North BC who now have three teams in the league. This makes a total of 21 teams competing across the weekend ready for next year's new arrangement into four divisions of 5 teams, presumably with the 21st and any new teams being in division 4.

The rules have been updated with the new format and a copy is attached.

Area Leagues

Last year the Gill Cup (North West Kent) lost two teams so was down to two divisions of five. This year Lindsey has worked very hard and has got both divisions back up to six teams. Once again Mike Griffiths has done his best with the Pearson Cup (South West Kent) but was unable to generate enough interest. So there are only three of the four area leagues running this season.


KCBA congress
