# 2. Matters Arising and Approval of Minutes of 70th AGM

The Acting Chair, John Slater, raised one matter arising and that was the appointment of Ken Langdon as Secretary. Ken was thanked for helping OBA out and for all his work during the year. The meeting concurred with the minutes and the Chair signed them off.

### 3. Acting Chair's report

He wished Robert Procter well in his recovery from illness and the meeting gave Robert a round of applause.

The Chair picked out as main points from his report:

The success of the Youth teams and he thanked Joan Bennett and Holly Kilpatrick for all their work

The movement from evening sessions to daytime sessions

The clubs that are doing well are the clubs that concern themselves with recruitment of beginners and teaching

Robert Procter was invited to talk about the Oxford Festival (OxFoB). Robert spoke about the email he had sent out to senior players suggesting that they might support the festival by encouraging other members and members of unaffiliated clubs to attend. Robert is looking for a fun event with a mixture of experienced and inexperienced players.

The Acting Chair emphasised the importance of the forthcoming year and especially the change in the role of the OBA towards encouraging more social bridge under its aegis and those of its clubs. This was in line with developments elsewhere.

Finally there would be a need to examine our Governance, the way the association manages itself, where we are out of line with other counties. We currently had a very large and unwieldy Management Committee

4. Treasurer's and Auditor's report and accounts for the year 2016/17 (for approval by AGM, including recommendation on County P2P amount for 2018/19):

The Treasurer pointed out that the Congress made money again, as did the competitions, although this was in part to do with the Duplimating service

She said that there was further scope to assist clubs with their efforts in marketing to new recruits

While the EBU was putting up Universal membership by 1p, she recommended that the OBA maintained its current levy of 6p

The Chair asked the meeting to approve the accounts subject to auditing. Richard Sills proposed and Alan Wilson seconded. The meeting approved

The meeting also approved Alison's recommendation on P2P, proposed by Robert Procter and seconded by Peter Briggs

Robert Procter thanked Claire for all her hard work over the years and the meeting gave her a hearty round of applause

# 5. Other reports:

EBU Shareholders report- Sandra

Sandra Nicholson wanted to add little to the written report. While the on-going finances of the EBU were a potential cause for concern, there was no immediate problem

### **County Team reports**

Alan Wilson commented on the success of the County in reaching the finals of the Tollemache cup.

He appealed for more people to volunteer for selection. He knew that people had a concern that the same players were always in the team but attributed this to the lack of new volunteers

#### **Competitions Committee report**

From his report John Slater picked out some points:

Entrants had dropped by about 10%. We need therefore to think about different types of competition. The number of teams in the Wessex league was also down and we may have to rethink the number of divisions

#### Congress organiser

Michael Robinson did not want to add to his report except to say that people should enter for this year's congress now

#### Membership secretary report

Peter Briggs attributed the increase in number of members to the work of Robert Procter. The clubs are generating new members and Peter is fairly optimistic for the future. Robert said we should look at social events like Bridge and tea. Ken suggested that we could have bridge and lunch or "Brunch".

#### **Education and Improvers report**

Ken Langdon said that we distributed £2,500 to clubs in grants and would look for other club projects this year if other things did not intervene.

#### County Youth Organiser's report

Joan Bennett stated that we were the best performing County in the Country and we should demonstrate this on the Website. We are going to repeat the Gloucestershire/Oxon event. It attracted more than 100 entrants last year. Holly Kilpatrick wondered if the County could replace the EBU grant that they had been receiving until now

#### Website report

The website has become more responsive to change over the year.
