BRIDGEMATES

In an informal discussion with a number of players, a consensus emerged that the club should follow Janet Parson's procedure of moving the Bridgemates in a counterclockwise rotation so that North passes it to East, then South, and finally West takes on the role of "Acceptor" and returns the Bridgemate to its resting position to the right of North.

MUMMERS 2016 FESTIVAL | NOV. 26 TO DEC. 14 MUMMERS PARADE | SATURDAY DEC. 10


