**Diamonds*

**Clubs*

All players mix and play against each other

Half-time and full-time results announced by section

Your result depends on how you have fared in the round compared with others grouped in your section

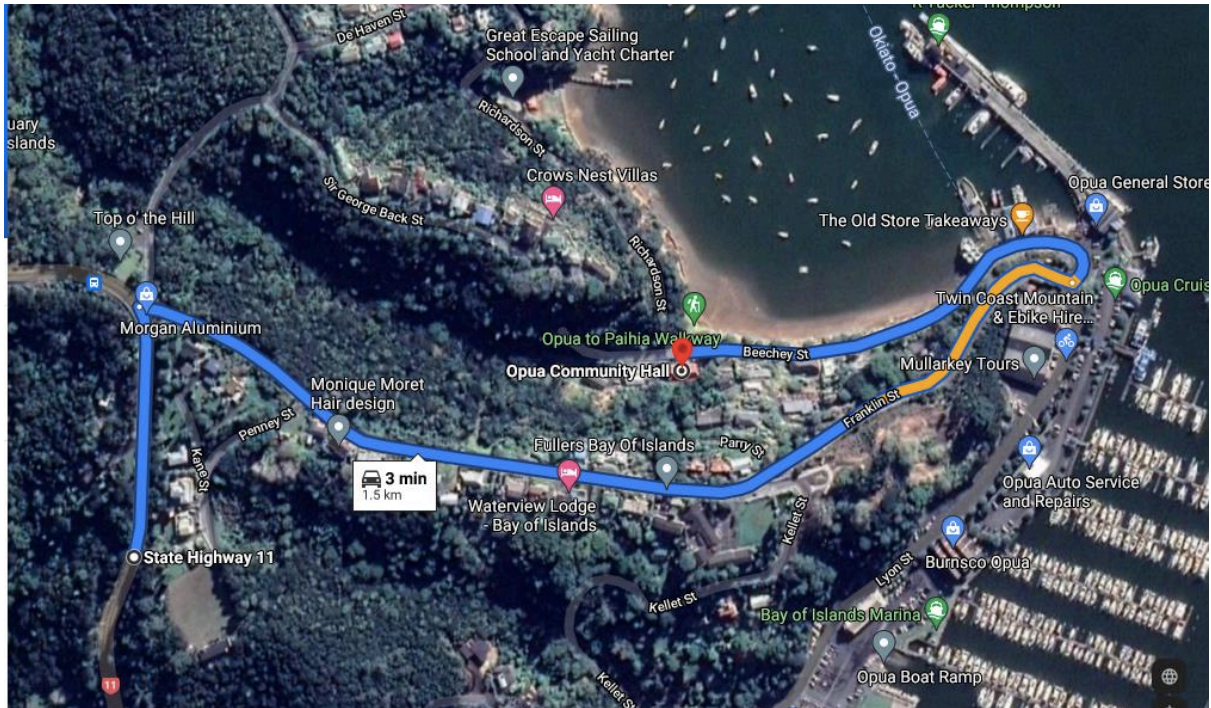

DIRECTIONS TO OPUA COMMUNITY HALL



From the South:

Take SH11 north towards Opuia. From Kawakawa roundabout it's about 12mins (10 kms) to the right turn to Opuia.

Turn right into Franklin Street - signposted **Opuia, Russell** and **Opuia Marina**

Take the non-ferry lane (right hand lane) which bends sharp left, past the Opuia General Store. Do not turn right into the Marina, or join the ferry lane.

Continue left into Beechey Street (watch out for ferry traffic!) and straight on to the Opuia Community Hall. Parking directly outside.

From the North:

Take SH11 south through Paihia. From Paihia it's about 7 mins (5 kms) to the left turn to Opuia.

Turn left into Franklin Street - signposted **Opuia, Russell** and **Opuia Marina**

Take the non-ferry lane (right hand lane), which bends sharp left, past the Opuia General Store. Do not turn right into the Marina, or join the ferry lane.

Continue left into Beechey Street (watch out for ferry traffic!) and straight on to the Opuia Community Hall. Parking directly outside.
