CHAIRMAN'S CUP AND PLATE COMPETITION

YOU DON'T HAVE TO SPECIALLY ENTER AND IT WILL HAVE NO IMPACT ON OUR USUAL DUPLICATE SESSIONS

There will be six designated qualifying rounds which will run in tandem with our normal Monday night sessions. During these heats, your pair's score will be retained and your four best results out of six will count towards an overall average score. This means pairs can miss two rounds and still be able to qualify for the special year-end finals night involving 24 pairs.

The 12 pairs achieving the best average scores will play for the Chairman's Cup in an all-play-all final and the next 12 pairs will play a similar final for the Chairman's Plate.

Pairs finishing outside the top 24, or who do not manage to have four counting scores, will not qualify. (Note: If any pair does not wish to play on finals night, the next best-placed pair will be invited to take their place.)

The qualifying rounds are on:

3 APRIL; 8 MAY; 5 JUNE; 3 JULY; 2 OCTOBER AND 30 OCTOBER.

Just turn up and play as normal.....the rest will be worked out after the sixth round. If you don't want to play on finals night that's fine. It is scheduled for **WEDNESDAY 13**th **DECEMBER** here at Ripley.
