


End of "Plan B"

We no longer have to wear face masks playing face to face.

We have had no transmission at the club that I know of. However, the level of cases of Covid is still very high. If you are fully vaccinated, your risk of serious illness is low. Although now usually mild, Covid can be unpleasant and take a long to recover from.

Colds and flu have been less common during the time we have changed our behaviour. We certainly haven't missed them. To keep us all healthy we propose to continue with most health measures:

- We will continue with the limit of five tables in each room, roughly half the pre pandemic density. We will continue with pre-booking.
- Please consider wearing a mask or visor at least when moving around the rooms. We still have some visors for sale.
- Stay one metre away from others ESPECIALLY if you are not wearing a face covering.
- Only TWO people at the tea / coffee counter at any time. Come back later.
- Players must be fully vaccinated and flu jabbed.
- **If you have tested positive, been in contact with someone who has tested positive, not feeling well, or have cold/flu/covid systems, don't come to bridge.**
- We will keep the ventilation up and use the HEPA air purifiers provided by the DSVH trustees.
- Keep the sanitising up and take your bidding box and sanitiser with you when moving
- Please consider using a lateral flow test before you come to bridge.
