BRIDGE TRAINING CLASSES

Dorking Bridge Club is pleased to announce its programme of duplicate bridge training classes for 2016 aimed at existing players who wish to improve their game or to return to playing after a break.

They will be led by Douglas Wright, a professionally qualified teacher with the English Bridge Union Teaching Association and a member of the Committee of the Surrey County Bridge Association.

The first session of four classes will be held at St Joseph's Church Hall, Falkland Grove, Dorking, Surrey RH4 3DL between 10.30am and 12.30 pm on the following Saturday mornings: **April 9, 16, 23 and 30**

Subsequently participants can, if they wish, enrol in the second session of four classes, which will also each be for two hours, where more advanced bidding and play techniques will be introduced. These will be held on: **Sept 24, October 1, 8, and 15.**

The cost for each four-week session is £69.50 per person.

After completing the first session participants will, if they wish, have the opportunity to play as visitors on one or more selected dates in our normal Club bridge evenings in order to gain exposure to duplicate play and put into practice what they will have covered in the classes.
