NEWS FLASH - Change to Bridge Membership Fees

Since GLL took over from Gosling (approximately a year ago), the bridge committee has been working with the new GLL management team to solidify our presence at the centre and safeguard the interests of our members. To this end, I am pleased to announce that The Committee have recently been able to agree with GLL that effective from 1st June 2017, our members will no longer have to pay annual GLL subscriptions in order to be a member of the Bridge club. Instead, all members will be offered a one year (£10) or three year (£25) Bridge membership, full details of which can be found on the website & club notice board. Table money will remain frozen at current levels until at least September 2019 when the arrangement will be reviewed. Visitors table money remains at £5 per session.

Refurbishment of the Bridge Room

We have been getting quotes for a new carpet and window treatments in addition to agreeing with GLL for all the walls and ceiling to be redecorated. All refurbishment work is due to be completed by the end of the summer!

In addition, we have now finished installing a new TV (for results and notices) and electric window openers to ensure that we do not overheat in the hot weather.

Finally, a new dishwasher is being fitted behind the bar so daytime session organizers will no longer have to unpack bar glasses from our own dishwasher.

New Committee Appointments

As of April 2017, Srimath Agalawatte has been appointed as the new Club's Tournament Director and co-opted on to the committee.

New Pairs League - To commence Wednesday 13th September 2017

It is proposed that the club introduces a new Club Pairs league competition to be held on the 2^{nd} Wednesday evening of the month. This will take the place of the club pairs event currently held on these dates.

We intend that there will be three Divisions – Premiership, One and Two – with promotion and demotion between divisions of one pair taking place every three months.

The introduction of a new evening competition is seen as a way to increase the number of players playing regularly on a Wednesday evening and to provide an attractive opportunity for additional strong players to play more frequently at the club.
