

## DISTRICT DIRECTOR REPORT FOR MAY 2015

Besides my duties as District Director on the National Level, on the District Level in addition to sitting on the Executive Committee, I am the chair of the Nominating Committee. Every two years ALACBU holds its elections for our corporate officers during our summer regional. This July we will hold elections. The election will be on Saturday July 11 during our meeting.

The ALACBU Bylaws state that each Unit shall have Directors to ALACBU proportionate to the Units' membership. Units with fewer than 100 members have one (1) Director; 100-300 members – two (2) Directors; 300 -600 members – three (3) Directors; and 600-1200 members – four (4) Directors. We do not have any Units over 1200 members (They would have five (5) Directors.)

Prior to the meeting it is important to identify the people from each Unit who are the voting designated Directors. I am asking each Unit President or Unit Board to let me know who will be attending and voting at the election meeting.

From the membership records I received from Horn Lake following are the number of Directors each of our nine units are entitled according to our Bylaws:
