## CARDING METHODS

|  | Primary method v. suit contracts | Primary method v. NT contracts |

## SUPPLEMENTARY DETAILS (continued)

6. Trump Asking Bids: (After $1 \star$ and a positive response) 012123
(in steps) $1=5+$, no hon, $2=5,1$ hon, $3=5$, 2 hons, $4=6,1$ hon, $5=6,2$ hons, $6=5+$ AKQ
Control Asking Bids: (in suit bid)
(in steps) $1=$ none, $2=3^{\text {rd }}$ round, $3=2^{\text {nd }}$ round, $4=1^{\text {st }}$ round, $5=$ Great Strength (AK or AQ)
Now the repeat of that suit asks whether length or strength
$1^{\text {st }}$ step shows Length, $2^{\text {nd }}$ step shows strength
The bid of a new suit asks in that suit - responses as above
