# **2/1 Game Forcing**

Stuck in the Dark Ages? *Still* playing Standard American Yellow Card?  
Time to get on board with 21<sup>st</sup> Century bridge!

The bidding system of choice for many experts and intermediate players alike, **Two Over One Game Forcing** is not a complete paradigm shift from SAYC. In fact, 2/1 features important modifications that help resolve many of the bidding ambiguities and difficulties of Standard American.

Have no fear! If you want to learn 2/1 the right way, join veteran instructor Curt Soloff for a four week course that includes the following:

- Understanding the advantages of 2/1
- First and second rounds of bidding by both opener and responder in game forcing auctions
- Thorough coverage of 1NT forcing
- The concept of *fast arrival* and when/how it is used
- Key bidding conventions that fit perfectly within the 2/1 system (i.e. Jacoby 2NT and splinter bids)
