From the BOARD: The CBC Board meeting was held at 6PM, February 23, 2000 at the Lizard's Thicket on Forest Drive across from the Richland Mall. Following are two decisions made by the Board.

- 1. Winners of the Tuesday afternoon, Wednesday night, and Thursday afternoon games will be given free plays in any Open game. There will be two pairs of winners in each of the 3 limited point games.
- 2. To provide uniformity in late play guidelines and breaks, the Board instructs the game Directors to provide a 5 minute break every 3 rounds in 3 board movements, and every 8 boards in 4 board and 2 board movements. In order to play all boards in a given round, players must have their lead to the first trick on the table with 3 minutes left in the round. Players may not use break time to make up slow play. First slow play gives each pair an average on the board. Second slow play is an average minus. If your opponents are playing slowly, summons the Director. This rule is also in effect on the last round, and applies to all games EXCEPT Easybridge!
