From the BOARD: The last CBC Board meeting was held at 6 PM, April 12, 2000 at the Lizard's Thicket on Forest Drive across from the Richland Mall. The meeting is open to all CBC members. Minutes from this meeting will be posted on the club house bulletin board.

Very Important: At a special meeting on April 26, 2000 your CBC Board unanimously accepted the recommendation of the Building Committee (comprised of Gwen Beckman, John MacGregor, Bob Webb, Genet Horning, Ellie Hack, Dave Collins and Harold Moore) which was as follows:

"In exchange for CBC property at 2725 Cypress Street, the Club would accept the Keenan Building located at 2628 Millwood Avenue"

This building has approximately 7,000 square feet which includes more than 4,000 square feet of playing space, adequate room to establish a Bob McMahan teaching Room, a four-stall ladies room and a three-stall men's room (with one handicap stall in each). This property has approximately 40 parking spaces. Along with acquisition of this building comes monthly rental income between \$1,100 and \$1,500.

The Board also authorized President Beckman to retain a licensed commercial building inspector whose report will be available at the May 9th Annual Membership Meeting.

MEETING ON TUESDAY, EVENING, MAY 9, AT 7:00 SHARP. We must have a quorum at that
meeting to officially authorize the Board to make this exchange of property. If you have any questions or
concerns, please do not hesitate to contact a member of the above listed Building Committee.

Annual Dues - Club Membership Dues are due on June 1, 2000: \$10.00 individual and \$18.00 couple. PLEASE do not put this off. Your membership dues are an important part of the Clubs funds that helps to pay for the Newsletter, Club Parties, and maintenance and utilities. An application is attached with this Newsletter.
