From the BOARD: The last CBC Board meeting was held on August 16, 2000.

Resignations: Secretary Chris Webb tendered his resignation, and Board Member at Large George Nichols resigned. The Board elected **John MacGregor** to complete the term as Member at Large. The Board elected **Joyce Lauterbach** to complete the term as Secretary.

The **Building Committee** reported that the property on which we hoped to build was not approved for the necessary zoning. The building committee is now considering our options.

At the motion and recommendation of Chairman of Directors, Michael Bitonti it was decided that the Thursday afternoon 0-100 game will be moved to Monday night at 7PM. The 0-100 and the 0-1000 games will be run separately and independent of each other. This change in schedule will take effect beginning Monday October 2, 2000. The response to this schedule change will be re-evaluated at the CBC Board meeting later in October.

The **kibitzing** policy is being revised to allow kibitzing in all games **Except** International Fund Games, Instant Match point, Silver point STAC, and ACBL Charity games. Directors are responsible for seeing that there is **no discussion** of the hands while kibitzing. It is proper courtesy and ethics to ask permission to kibitz at a table. Any player may decline having his table kibitzed by any other player, and kibitzers should gracefully respect the wishes of those who do not wish to have the play kibitzed at their table.

The scores will be cumulative, and your best four games will count. The rules are that you must play with at least four different partners to be eligible for the overall prizes. (If you play with the same partner more than once that is okay, but only your *first* score with that partner will count.) Prizes will be awarded in three different categories, and they will be for the players with over 1500 Master Points, 500-1500 Master Points, and under 500 Master Points. First place in each category will be awarded three free plays. Second in each category will be awarded two free plays, and third in each category will be awarded one free play.
