A request for the best "going for the Gold" strategy has been received from an NLM. Well, play good bridge at Regional events. Seriously, don't restrict your play to the 0-300 events but play Open Stratified events. Those are Gold point events and also improve your game. Continuous Pairs are good bets as well as being good for your game. Hold your cards back!!! Those of us with bifocals have a habit of giving unscrupulous players an edge. Play Knock-out teams. Win two matches and you're golden. Try to hook up with a pair better than you and play "up" a bracket or two. (Assuming they're willing to play down.) KO teams are your very best bet for Gold points. Finally this (paraphrasing Mike Lawrence, my nominee for best player ever): Concentration is critical. This is a competition rather than a social event. Nothing matters except the bidding and the play on the table. Nothing outside the four planes determined by the edges of table matters. Other players get tired, discouraged, distracted by bad (or good) results-not you!!!
