The CBC Board met with a group of members representing by petition a sizable minority of the players in the club concerning an increase in card fees. Or come to think of it, since nothing is guaranteed, while we're still here.

A flight 'C' player planning to move up asks "What conventions should I add first as I move into the Open games?" First, remember no convention comes with a guarantee against disaster. Don't try to add too many at once, but I would suggest 3 areas. 1) You need a 2-suit interference bid against opponents' opening 1 NT. Revised Landy, Brozel, DONT, Cappaletti-talk it over with your partner and pick one. 2) You need to be able to handle opponents' interference with your 1 NT opening bids. Play Lebensohl! Do not let any one talk you into playing "Stolen"!!!!!!

3) Use that red X card in your bid box that increases under trick penalties. Use it on part score auctions. Don't take every push, hit them instead!!! Learn the Law of Total Tricks and play defense!!! It's the last thing any player learns, but it pays big time.
