Let me share this portion of an article by Larry Cohen from Bridge World on the Bermuda Bowl Trial final for USA 1 won by the Nickell team. "S-QJT5, H-QJ8, D-QJ5, C-KT6. Becker and Meckstroth both opened this... (Becker with one natural club, Meckstroth with one amorphous diamond) When their partners responded one spade, they chose the sensible rebid of 1 NT. This produced a push at plus 90; raising spades would have produced a minus." Just a reminder with an endorsement by top pros and editors that **shape** and **size** matter sometimes more than fit. Along this line, here is a hand I held at the club S-86, H-AQ95, D-KQ72 C-Q53. I opened 1D and my partner responded 1S. At this point I figured we could be in trouble but made the natural call of 1NT. Fortunately, I was playing against a pair that was never going to let anyone play 1NT. Sure enough, they balanced into 2 Hearts and we went plus. Partner held S-K974 H-J2 D-T63 C-K984. Those allowed to play 1 NT made 6 tricks though one only made 5. One unfortunate opened One Club and had his partner bid 3 Clubs over their balancing. He went for 3 doubled. Point is: 1 of a minor and a response of 1 of a major followed by 1 NT-the hands almost always look like this. You want to play the hands that fit, let the opponents play the misfits.

There isn't room for all the section winners from Columbia at the Charleston Regional, but here are a few highlights: Wayne Hollingsworth won a two session Open Pairs. Pat and Bob Webb paired with Pat and Joyce Lauterbach to win a Bracket II KO event and then with Dr. Fred to be 3-4 in the Morning KO's. Linda York and Ed Scheiblich won almost 18 points by winning one and being 2nd in another KO event. Ken Fasching and Rod Severson won a Morning KO bracket.
