We had an unfortunate committee decision recently in a failure to alert sequence. I awarded an adjusted score to the injured party but an appeals committee allowed self-serving statements by the pair that made the infraction and allowed them to place themselves in the perfect contract making the maximum number of tricks instead of the score I awarded. The one certified director on the committee should have known better than to allow this. (Here's a hint-find another director who doesn't laugh out loud at the decision) Do not take this as a precedent-as soon as I figure out what went wrong with the process-maybe Janet Case or Alan Brooks will help me out-we are going to fix this.

Marty (Bergan) seyz: When raising partner's major, High Card points are not the key: Distribution points are. Distribution points = High Card points plus short suit points:

single raise = 6-9 (or a bad 10) distribution points

limit raise = 10-12 distribution points

forcing raise = 13+ distribution points

Once you have a fit, short suits are just as valuable as high cards. Therefore you should never think or say "This bid promises --- HCP."

Once partner raises your suit, generously add points for trump length. If your hand contains a singleton or void, add 1 point for a five card trump holding. After that add two points for every trump beyond 5 that you hold (2 points for 6, 4 for seven...) Also when your major is raised, add on for short suits 3 for a void, 2 for a singleton and 1 for a doubleton.
