Just talking to the flight C players and their partners at some open games last month. Random observations from those players: 1) The people who make Open games a chore are either missing or on their best behavior in Over/Under Games. Several partnerships of less than 700 have started showing up at these events for that reason. 2) "Why do we have convention cards if any jackass can come in and psych at will? You know that no matter what they say, the partner knows and we get flim flammed-that's no fun." (We're in the entertainment biz-no one likes the feeling of being had. Charlotte has a policy-you get a zero if you psych-no prohibition-go ahead and psych if you want-but you get a zero. What do you think? The subject is on the agenda for the next Board meeting.) 3) "It's just hopeless playing against players like you." (Well thanks-but I only got 1 more matchpoint that round than you did. And you left me with a zero on the board where you made that comment.) 4) "The hands are really against us tonight-we've been on defense for ever." (OK-here's something the very best players will tell you if you ask-It is more rewarding to take your expected tricks on defense than to take your expected number of tricks on offense. Some other pairs will fail on defense due to disinterest or ineptitude and give declarer extra tricks-more matchpoints for you if you can play defense. BUT you have to know how to defend. Respect your partner's defensive signals. Have a picture in your mind-and a reason why that picture is reasonable-before the play begins.) 5) "They got in our auction and we got a zero." Ron Anderson, Marty Bergan, lots of other pros say don't let opponents play 1 NT, don't let them play 2S or 2 Hearts or below. But what do you do if that's the limit of your assets and they bid over you? Well, have you ever been to Chucky Cheese's and watched the kids play Whack-a-Mole? They don't nail the little rodent every time out, but the score mounts up until he doesn't come out anymore. USE THE DOUBLE CARD. You're losing to these bids anyway, how much worse is it if you eat a double now ant then? And the doubles going down will be great results. Try it.

There were nine tables for the Over/Under game. Again this month, everyone had a great time. One of the more popular events on our calendar. Get a partner and *play* next month. Regular entry fee.
