The problem for top experts at <u>The Bridge World</u> was the following: In the hand below, what card (labeled Y) would you have to hold in order to open in first seat? Their answer next page. What's yours? S-A 10 7 4 3 H----- D-(Y) 5 4 C-KO 8 6 5

Of the 30 experts, 5 wanted the King, 14 wanted the Queen and 8 wanted a Jack (plus Steve Robinson and Zia). So what's the minimum on a distributional hand where the rebid can be awkward? "The Queen was the most common answer, indicating that experts want something that really looks like an opening bid when there may be rebid problems." (Of course any who would open without at least the Queen/Jack probably never in their life had a rebid problem either. *PKL*) You want to open a Spade or a Club on your minimum?
