From <u>"52 Facts of Bridge Life"</u> by Eddle Kantar. 3) With two five card suits: Open the higher ranking suit, respond in the higher ranking suit and overcall in the higher ranking suit. Do not worry about which is the stronger suit,

You hold: S-x H-J-10-xxx D- AKQxx C- Kx

Open 1H, not 1D, respond 1H to an opening 1C bid (and) overcall 1H if the bid to your right is 1C.

4) When the bid to your right is strong, a jump by you is weak; when the bid to your right is weak, a jump by you is strong.

If partner opens 1C and RHO doubles, a jump to 2S by you is weak. If RHO opens 2H (weak), a jump to 3S by you is strong. (You don't pre-empt a pre-empt.)
