Facts of Bridge Life (Eddie Kantor) #9 When responding to a takeout double, jump the bidding in your long suit with 9-11 "revalued points." An unbid five card suit is worth 1 extra point and an unbid six-card suit is worth three extra points. Do not count points for jacks and queens in suits opponents have bid.

You hold: Spades A-Q-T-x-x Hearts K-x-x Diamonds x-x Clubs 10-x-x-x

West 1 Spade North Double East Pass South (you)- Jump to 2 spades. Do not bid One Spade which shows 0-8 points. Also, your jump is not forcing

Fact #10 When responding to a takeout double with 12+ High card points, cuebid the opponents' suit to show a strong hand and then bid your suit(s) later. After you cuebid, any new suit by you is forcing.

You hold: Spades KQxx Hearts AJxx Diamonds Qxx Clubs xx

West 1 Club North Double East Pass South (you) Bid 2 clubs to show a big hand (12+) You and partner then bid four-card suits up the line until you connect in a 4-4 major fit. If partner bids two diamonds, bid two hearts, if partner bids two Spades, raise to four spades. The one who knows, goes.
