I have to have a word with some of the people doing the King Canute bit concerning keeping the flight C and even those below 1500 MP from having to compete with 'A' players. It quite simply can't be done. For starters: You'll notice that we have 4 nominally 'C' players in the top 10 for master points in the Open Sol Lourie race for points won at the CBC. When I started directing the Wednesday night 0-50 (then 0-300 and 0-500) Wednesday night game, Ken Fasching was a regular-now his point count is what? Eighth or ninth in the club at around 3000 nine years later. When we moved here, Joyce had a little over 800 points, almost all Gold, Red or what would now be Silver plus two trips in two tries to the final two (of six) rounds of the Blue Ribbon Pairs (the first before she had 300 points for LM). I recently played against a lady who read her partner the riot act over his actions in an auction at my table: She was right on every count and delivered her remarks in a style I've been (well) known to use. She has less than 10 points but I can tell she's going to be good. There are others. There is a flip side concerning some of the nominally A players but let's not go there. The point is, "A" is not a point count!! Lots of "A"s just don't have very many-yet. They are always among you.

Our current policy of all special sanction games will have to change. This is not a local club policy change but comes direct from ACBL. The motion below was passed by the ACBL National Board of Directors in Reno NV. The effective date is July 1, 2010.

The month of February is reserved for Junior Fund Games, the month of April is reserved for charity games and the month of September is reserved for International Fund games and in those months any and all ACBL sanctioned club sessions may be special games for the named funds. In the remaining nine months of the year one game per month per sanctioned session may be a special game for the Junior Fund, International Fund, Educational Foundation or charity.

We were playing the opposing captain and a 13 year old hotshot-and losing-in a second round top bracket KO. Talking about the last hand where I under led an off-suit (not bid by partner) king on opening lead. Opposing captain says "I used to do that-but results were just too bad so I don't do it unless I can't help it anymore." I wouldn't mention this except opposing captain's name was Rodwell.

For new players-a few random thoughts: If you get a lead in a suit where you are missing the Ace and Queen, the lead is from the Queen or from nothing. Good defenders don't under lead aces against suit contracts **unless** the strong hand is going down on dummy. You will underlead a king more often than a Jack. Leading partner's suit, you normally under lead the honor third. If you think you might want to switch, lead your honor in partner's suit to possibly retain the lead and have a look a dummy. Consider whether you want to continue or switch. (This is one reason why it's important not to overcall bad suits)
