These races include all games played here at CBC, Match points as well as team games. (8 is enough, GNT) Next month I will print the winners of the McMahon Trophies (winners in four divisions). Those games will count only match point games.

Next year, these point trophy races won't have numbers that look anything like this year's results. Starting July 1, our ability to run special sanction games is reduced by ACBL to one a month. The special sanction games will pay only 70% of Sectional rating instead of 100%. There will also be a top limit on the awards for single session events.

We have a lot of the usual suspects in the top tens this year plus some new players making a splash. When "doing the math" to figure out who to be most wary of in the game you're in, consider that the 4 players in the Mills, Farrell and Centurion races that also made the Open list, play Limited games on Tuesdays and Fridays that only pay 80% (or less) of what an Open game pays. Of course next year we'll have players moving up due to rank change or point accumulation. Good luck all!
