The Question: What is a 'Field fix?" That is when the opposing pair does something either really brilliant or really off-beat that results in a very poor result for you while the rest of their field is in a more mundane spot or makes a more mundane play. Ex. They are in 6 Clubs making while the field is in 3 NT making 5. Or they stop in 3 Spades making while the rest of their field is in 4 down one.

Closely related: 'Lack of field protection" This is when you do something routinely brilliant that you'd expect any other world class player to do, but it ends up a poor score in a disaster that no one else in your field finds because they aren't as brilliant as you are.
