Master, a clear favorite has jumped out to an early lead, but in the Centurion Under 1000 category, there is already a tight race for first place. The Sol Lourie Open category includes everyone who is a member of our club. And remember, only points won at our local games are included in the totals. Mohan Bali

is continuing his onslaught from last year and is leading the pack with 111.22 masterpoints. Hap Neuffer and Alice Moore come in second and third, both approximately 26 points back. Jay Shahani checks in at the number four slot while seventh slots. Pat Webb, Bernetha Henry, and Brent Holcomb round out the top ten.

Al Kirkland, Jack Wilkinson, and Carolyn Cromer are neck and neck for the fifth through The **Henry Mills Under 2000** category includes, like the name says, everyone who had fewer than 2000 masterpoints as of June 1, 2017. Jack Wilkinson leads the way with just over 50 masterpoints with Bernetha Henry trailing him by 8 points in second place. The third through sixth spots are all closely contested by Frances Robinson, Beth Watson,

Bill Charlwood, and Mike Bitonti. Scott McPherson and Scott Dunn are vying for the seventh and eighth places while Marianne Murphy and Jack Self complete the top ten.

The Coleman-Farrell Non-Life Master category includes everyone who has not yet competed the requirements for the coveted gold card. Leading the way is Beth Watson with almost 31 masterpoints followed closely by Kathy Kimmerling with over 25. Janet Sheridan and Mary Frame are in close competition for the third and fourth places while Brenda Isbell, Shelby King, and Sally McCardle are bunched together in the fifth, sixth, and seventh slots. Helen Young, Sharon Bowen, and Hillary McDonald together round out the top ten.

The Centurion Under 100 category includes those who have not yet reached 100 masterpoints and is usually the most tightly contested category of the four. This year is certainly no exception with Myra Jaynes and Charmelle Staples leading the way with almost 16 masterpoints but separated by just a small fraction. Glen Mitchell and Eddie Crosby come in third and fourth with both having just over 11 masterpoints. Judy Sternberg and Stella Donelan are neck and neck for the fifth and sixth slots while Hilde Moore, Martha Beckman, Bob McCardle, and Ginny Carrier complete the list of the top ten.

Remember, the categories you are eligible for are based on your masterpoint holding as of June 1, the start of this fiscal year. If you feel you have been put into the wrong category, please let us here at the newsletter know so you can be properly placed. It is too early to concede any of the cup races. Indeed, we have not even reached the halfway point of the year. So join your partner at the table and remind everyone that you might just replace them on the top ten list next month. 
