Club professional (national champion), Kevin Wilson does three short (45 min) lessons each week on BBO. They are called Bridge Bites with Kevin. They are at 12 noon on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays. They are free. Go on BBO and look for Kevin. His BBO player name is "Grypho". Click on his name and then, in the popup box that appears,

click JOIN to come to his table. They use BBO Voice and Zoom for each session. On Monday he does hands of the week, on Wednesdays he does a series (currently on the 12) habits of highly effective bidders - very advanced), and on Saturdays he usually answers

questions that people send through email or BBO mail.

Live postmortems six days a week after both the 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM games. They are also free. Jim Ricker (ABTA Teacher of the Year) does the majority of these.  Pre-alert by announcing to opponents any system that includes at least one 1-level Opening Bid that is not Natural or that is Forcing. An example is the strong 1.

 If you are not sure whether to Alert a call, err on the side of Alerting it. You should Alert a call that requires (or may require) an Alert even if you do not remember its meaning. However, do not Alert any call that this document says not to Alert. In other words, more info to the opponents via the announcement box on the bid is a

Transfers to a specific suit are now made by saying the suit name, not the word
