Your correct play is to play the ◆9 and NOT the ◆K. You know your partner does not have the A. He would NEVER under-lead an Ace against a suit contract (that is a HUGE no-no in the bridge world). So you know declarer has the A and will capture your K making dummy's ◆Q good. So you play the ◆9 hoping your partner has the ◆J and declarer will

First, remember, your partner is not under-leading the Ace. Like I said, that is one of the

Second, when your partner leads low, he either has a singleton or he has three of them (he would lead high if he had a doubleton). So the chances are pretty good he has the

Third, playing the ♦9 cannot lose. If declarer does have the ♦J, then you are going to limit declarer to two tricks in diamonds, whereas playing the •K will give declarer three tricks.

This is a situation that comes up all the time, so be ready for it and when it does occur, you
