WHERE DO THE GAMES COME FROM?!

There are at least 3 different types of games offered at the club, scheduled from 3 different people/groups. At the top level are the games dictated by the ACBL. Examples are the International Fund Game and the ACBL Charity games, etc.; you can find these listed in the Bulletin's Special Events Calendar (in March, on page 97) and also in the pocket calendars you can get from the ACBL. Our club must hold these on the dates specified by the ACBL. Next are the Unit games, which are conducted Unit-wide and can be Swiss or Pairs, Charity or not, and are held on a variety of days (i.e. Wed., 3/13; Tues., 3/19; Mon., 4/8; Mon., 5/13; Thu., 5/30, etc.). All of the above are open and stratified and sometimes have hand records.

The majority of the other special games are set locally - in past years at CBC by a director and/or the secretary/club manager. We get a certain number of club championships and charity club championships per year per game (i.e. per Monday pm, per Tuesday noon...). For qualifying games (NAOP and GNT) we are given a certain period of time during which we may have as many as we want to schedule. Special games like the series games, individuals and the master/non-life master games may be held anytime and as

often as we like, since they are simply club games with a special twist.

Periodically the ACBL will offer more points for special games during a certain month, for example, the Junior games last month. Information on these games is sent to the club manager, who may turn our regular game into one of these special games at his/her discretion. So... on with the games!

GNT FLIGHT C QUALIFYING

While our Flight C club games may have a variable upper limit, qualifying games held nationwide have set criteria. If you were a non-life master or had fewer than 500 points prior to your point card of September 1, 1995, then you are eligible to play in Flight C of the GNT's.
