Club Manager: The three point races -Coleman-Farrell, Henry Mills and Sol Lourie - run from June 1 through May 31 of each year. With the start of the new "year" just a couple of months away, we will be re-establishing your eligibility for each race. While all points won at the club level EXCEPT Unit, semi-final and final rounds of the NAP, GNT are counted in the race, your eligibility for the lower two races is based on your total point count from all ACBL games. Therefore, when you receive your June BULLETIN with your masterpoint total, please REPORT THAT NUMBER TO THE **CLUB MANAGER** to determine what category you'll be in. If you qualify for the Coleman-Farrell (<49.9999 points as of 6/1), you will also be eligible for the other 2; if for the Henry Mills (NLM as of 6/1), then also for the Sol Lourie. Travelling trophies are awarded annually.
