JUNE BRINGS NAOP QUALIFYING

North American Open Pairs qualifying begins at the club level this month. We will have several games; during our regularly scheduled open games you will be able to qualify in all 3 flights. Check with the director or the club secretary to get the flight parameters; best guess is that "C" is non-life master under 500 points; "B" is life master up to 1500 points; and "A" is open. The top half of the field in each flight qualifies, and a C pair who qualifies in A is automatically qualified in B and C. The next round is usually in Aiken in September.
