## ENTRY FEES

There has been some discussion concerning entry fees at the Club. CBC pays ACBL \$1.00 per game and then \$.50 per table for each club game we hold. For example, for the month of June CBC held 17 games with a total of 98 tables. We paid ACBL \$66.00.

Directors get \$30 for a 1 session game with fewer than 6 tables; \$40 for a 1 session game over 6 tables and \$60 for a 2 session game. CBC pays the director \$20 if there are not enough tables to hold a game.

The Columbia Bridge Club does not charge extra for special games such as the NAOP games, Charity games, etc. Any additional money paid by players above \$3.50 is charged by the "sponsor" of that game - i.e. ACBL, the Unit, etc. - and is sent directly to that organization.

Our tournament starts at 7:30 on Thursday night, Aug. 7, at the Capital Senior Center. Thursday's game is a stratified pairs game, with strats of 0 - 300, 300 - 1500, and 1500+. Friday's pairs start at 2 & 8; Saturday's Palmetto Cup and Trotter Cup at 1:30 and 7:30 (these are single session games); and Sunday's team game at 10:30. \$7.50 per session; \$68 per team.
