From the BOARD: The next CBC Board meeting will be at 6PM, December 8, 1999 at the Lizard's Thicket on Forest Drive across from the Richland Mall. The meeting is open to all CBC Members. Dinner is Dutch Treat.

It was requested that excerpts from a Memorandum written by Board Member Jack Wilkinson regarding kibitzing be published in this edition of your Newsletter. The Memorandum in its entirety is posted on the Bulletin Board at the Bridge House. (Remember that kibitzing at special games at the Columbia Bridge Club is not allowed by participating players.)

First, permission should be asked for and given for kibitzing. Although not found in the laws, it is a common courtesy.

A kibitzer must assume the role of an observer, or spectator and not be a participant in any way. A
kibitzer may not call attention to any irregularity or mistake, nor speak on any question of fact or law
except by request of the Director.

 A kibitzer must not display any reaction to the bidding or play while a hand is in progress - not cringe, laugh, or walk away during the round. A kibitzer must refrain from mannerisms or remarks of any kind, including conversation with a player.

• If a kibitzer is a player enjoying a bye round, then he should not compare scores with the players he is kibitzing.
