5 Treasurer's Report

I can report the year-end audit has been successfully completed and the independent Examiner of Accounts,

Richard Anscombe, has provided an unqualified opinion. I thank him for his help and advice.

I want to thank everyone who has helped with financial matters and the running of the club. Special mentions go to David and Hilary Powell for their help in installing Bridgewebs attendance module, Richard Creamer for his input on the website, Jenny Kerr for help during rent negotiations and last but not least Wendy Church who saves us £2.500 per year in catering costs.

The accounts show a surplus of £99.60, down £1626.61 on 2022, due mainly to token repayments and increases in catering costs, hall rental and competition fees. At the start of the year 302 tokens were in circulation, so £755 was credited to members. On April 1st hall rent rose 18% to £13 per hour (the first increase for 4 years) and catering costs (and consumption) have risen throughout the year. Add this to cost of entering 4 teams, including lunch, in the Corbett Cup and a small loss at the Christmas party, and our finances have taken a hit.

As costs continue to increase, I propose that subscriptions should be increased to £12 (backdated to August 1st, 2023) and Table Money should go up to £3 per session (effective October 1st, 2023).In 2022 we averaged 8.5 tables a session, and that has increased to 8.7 tables (870 tables in 100 sessions) in 2023. We currently have 124 members, one more than last year.

As this is my first and last report as Treasurer, I would like to thank you all for your patience whilst we changed from the token system to invoicing in arrears., and to remind everyone that it would help my successor hugely if you make sure that you only put your EBU number down on all payment references.

John Hunt proposed acceptance of this report, seconded by Rodney Meredith. All in favour.

Richard Anscombe was thanked by the membership for his work.

<u>6 Election of Independent Examiner of Accounts</u>

Richard Anscombe agreed to undertake this task for 23/24.

He was proposed by Richard Creamer and seconded by Jan Johnson. All in favour.

7.Election of Officers

Of the 2 candidates for Chairman, Mike Rafferty was proposed by Norman Selway and seconded by Kay Preddy, Chris Clegg was proposed by Marian Hunt and seconded by Robert Kendall. All the proxy votes and the votes from the room were counted, Chris Clegg was declared the winner and new Chairman. There was one nomination for the post of Treasurer: John Hunt, proposed by Chris Clegg and seconded by Rodney

Meredith. There was one proposal for Hon.Secretary: Jo Lightfoot proposed by Lesley Pechey, seconded by Roger Pechey. These 2 posts were unanimously accepted

There were 3 nominations for committee members: Wendy Church, proposed by Christine Kempton, seconded by Marian Hunt; Rodney Meredith, proposed by Mike Rafferty, seconded by Bob Manser; and Joan Chandler, proposed by Jo Lightfoot and seconded by Gordon McBride. All these proposals were accepted.

The new Chairman, thanked Mike Rafferty for his time as chairman and the room gave Mike a warm round of applause.

8:Subscriptions and Table Money

The outgoing treasurer, Chris Clegg, proposed that subscriptions should increase by a pound to £12, backdated to August 1st, 2023 and that table money be increased to £3 per session, effective from October 1st,2023. Acceptance of this proposal was by John Hunt, seconded by Leila Williams. The room voted in favour unanimously.

Norman Inniss commented that we already have considerable reserves and he hoped the expanding revenue would be used constructively.

9.Proposals

The secretary had received 2 proposals for consideration from Graham Clements:

1. The committee should establish procedures for effective communication with members and these procedures should be made explicit in the club's constitution.

After discussion this proposal was considered to be covered effectively under 5.6 and 5.7 of the constitution The Chairman said he intended more efficient use of the website.

2. The committee should review all sections of the current constitution to ensure that it is both practical and fit for purpose. Approval for the complete revised version to be sought at the next AGM.

The hon. Secretary reported that at present there is no list of members' addresses held by the club .There are only email and phone numbers.The constitution requires a list of addresses.

After discussion John Hunter suggested that this second proposal be turned down. A show of hands supported this view.

John Hunt was thanked for preparation of trophies. Chris invited Mike to present the trophies. Mike was reluctant but they were presented between him and John.
