RECOMMENDED MOVEMENTS FOR MULTI – TEAMS

Standard Move: EW pairs DOWN 2 tables dropping the boards DOWN 1 table

Double Move: EW pairs DOWN 4 tables dropping the boards DOWN 2 tables

In the instructions below it is assumed that the boards have been pre-dealt.

Instructions written in green are for Scorers.

Instructions written in red are for Bridgemates.

6 Teams 27 board American Whist

Arrange tables in two rows of 3 tables. Table 1 shares with 4, 2 & 5, 3 & 6.

Put out **4 boards** between each pair of sharing tables (1 – 12).

Round 1 & 2 – Standard Move (EW down 2, boards down 1)

Put out 3 new **5 board** sets between each pair of sharing tables (13 – 27).

Round 3 – EW pairs DOWN 3 tables, boards remain

Round 4 & 5 – Standard Move

(6 Teams 5 Rounds Stagger EBU page 131)

7 Teams 28 board American Whist 4 boards per table

Round 1 – EW pairs DOWN 2 tables, boards remain

Round 2 to 6 - Standard Move

(American Whist Odd EBU page 128)

8 Teams 28 board American Whist

Arrange tables in two rows of 4. Table 1 shares with 5, 2 & 6, 3 & 7, 4 & 8.

Put out **4 boards** between each pair of sharing tables (1 – 16).

Round 1, 2 & 3 – Standard Move (EW down 2, boards down 1)

Put out 4 new **3 board** sets between each pair of sharing tables (17 – 28).

Round 4 – EW pairs DOWN 3 tables, boards remain

Round 5, 6 & 7 - Standard Move

(8 Teams 7 Rounds Stagger EBU page 131)

9 Teams 27 board American Whist 3 boards per table

Round 1 – EW pairs DOWN 2 tables, boards remain

Round 2 to 8 - Standard Move

(American Whist Odd EBU page 128)

10 Teams 30 board American Whist 3 boards per table

Round 1 – EW pairs UP 4 tables, boards remain

Round 2 – Standard Move

Round 3 – Double Move (EW pairs DOWN 4 tables, boards DOWN 2 tables).

Round 4 – Standard Move

Round 5 – EW pairs DOWN 3 tables, boards DOWN 1 table

Round 6,7 & 8 – Standard Move.

(American Whist Score Break EBU page 130)

11 Teams 33 board American Whist 3 boards per table

Round 1 – EW pairs DOWN 2 tables, boards remain. Play THREE boards.

Round 2 – Standard Move, play THREE boards

Round 3-8 – Standard Move, BUT play only the TWO lower numbered boards

Round 9 & 10 – Standard Move, BUT play all THREE boards

(American Whist Odd EBU page 128)

(Before upload to website, when asked, delete lines with missing scores, where board was not played)

(In rounds 3-8 enter 0 or NO PLAY for highest numbered board)

12 Teams 36 board American Whist 3 boards per table

Round 1 – EW pairs UP 4 tables, boards remain

Round 2 – Standard Move

Round 3 – Double Move (EW pairs DOWN 4 tables, boards DOWN 2 tables).

Round 4 – Standard Move

Round 5 – EW pairs DOWN 3 tables, boards DOWN 1 table. Play TWO lower numbered boards only.

Round 6 to 10 – Standard Move, BUT play TWO lower numbered boards only.

(American Whist Score Break EBU page 130)

(Before upload to website, when asked, delete lines with missing scores, where board was not played)

(In round 5-10 enter 0 or NO PLAY for highest numbered board)

13 OR MORE TEAMS – 12 rounds of 2 boards per round.

ODD NUMBER OF TABLES

American Whist 2 boards per table.

Round 1 – EW pairs DOWN by total number of tables MINUS 11, boards remain

Standard Move for further eleven rounds.

(American Whist Odd EBU page 128 – set number of rounds to 12)

EVEN NUMBER OF TABLES

American Whist 2 boards per table.

Round 1 – EW pairs UP 6 tables, boards remain

Round 2 & 3 – Standard Move

Round 4 – Double Move (EW pairs DOWN 4 tables, boards DOWN 2 tables).

Round 5 & 6 – Standard Move

Round 7 – EW pairs UP 5 tables from Home Table, boards DOWN 1 table.

Round 8 to 12 – Standard Move.
