The top 4 teams from each division will go forward to the "A" final, the rest will play in the "B" final. In the final, you will play teams that qualified from the other division.

The dates for the 4 games of the finals are: Feb 8, Feb 22, Mar 8 and Mar 22

SYLVIA ROSE 2016/2017 RULES OF COMPETITION

- 1) The matches are scored on a VP basis from the ranges shown on the team card. The winner shall be the team with the most VP's at the end of all the rounds.
- 2) The carry forward into the main final is all the VP's scored against the teams who qualify for the main final from your division, but only 50% of the VP's scored against other teams. The carry forward to the secondary plate final is the full VP score of all matches.
- 3) Each team is allowed to have up to six nominated names and these people must be members of the club. Each nominated person is allowed to play for this team only, but other players can be used and these players can play for more than one team. Please try the listed reserves if you are short.
Failing that you can use reserves who are non-members of Farnham Bridge club on an occasional basis.
- 4) All matches should ideally be played on the dates shown, although the matches can be arranged privately (please let organiser know if you plan to do this). If a match is switched to be played at the Memorial Hall on a normal club duplicate night, then only the team that requested the switch in dates needs to pay table money of £12 for their team. This goes towards hall rental.. All results should be confirmed to the organiser as soon as they are played. All matches for the first half have to be played by 28th January or the match will be assigned a result.
- 5) If a team fails to turn up on the date agreed, or is more than 30 minutes late, then that team automatically loses the match and scores zero VPs. The VP score of the non-offending team is the highest of the following:
 - a) Average of the 'winners' scores for all division or finals matches, rounded to the highest number (eg 11.1 becomes 12)
 - b) The minimum win (i.e 11 – 9)
 - c) The average of the 'losers' scores deducted from the maximum win (i.e 20) and rounded to the highest number

In the event of a team withdrawing from the league part-way through the competition, the team defaults all its matches.

- 6) If, at the end of the competition, two or more teams have scored the same number of VPs then the split will be done as recommended in the E.B.U.'s directors handbook.
- 7) All play must be completed by 10.45. All boards that have not been started by this time will be declared void. An award of 3 imps per board not played, to the non-offending side, may be made if one team has arrived late.
