The Hotel

The 3★★★ Corbyn Head Hotel is one of a group of 3 owned by the Rew family, and is situated on the seafront, with a magnificent view of Torbay. The town is about 10 minutes' walk, and there is a bus-stop right outside the hotel.

The bedrooms are on the ground and first floors, all with en-suite bath- or shower-rooms. There is no lift.

For single people, the hotel has offered that all guests will be guaranteed a double room for single occupancy, with no supplement, subject to availability.

An upgrade to a sea-view is available at a cost of £10 per person per night (ie £30 for the 3-day break).

The hotel is noted for its good food, and high standard of service. Breakfast and Dinner are included; you will have to make your own arrangements for lunch. Bar meals are available at the hotel.

*We shall be playing bridge in the **Lounge**, on the ground floor, with large windows, comfortable chairs and good lighting for the evening sessions. It has just been re-decorated.*

There is a possibility for arranging a private visit one morning, to Greenways, the home of Dame Agatha Christie, now owned by the National Trust. This depends on their opening times, yet to be confirmed. Transport will be arranged, the total cost is likely to be in the region of £20 (no reduction for NT members, as this will be a private visit). Please indicate your likely interest on the booking form.

Travel

Rover European, of Stroud, will pick up passengers from Ross and Newent on Sunday morning, and there will be a short comfort stop on the way. We aim to arrive at the hotel in the early afternoon, where tea and coffee will be served whilst the hotel staff put your luggage into your rooms.

We shall leave the hotel on Wednesday morning, returning to Newent and Ross by lunchtime – ready for Club Bridge in the evening!

Paul and Hylary will be directing and hosting, and everyone is guaranteed a game whenever they wish to play. Afternoon sessions are optional. The popular singles competition will be run over the first four sessions, the last session will be Teams, picked randomly. Master Points will be issued at all sessions.

There will be short optional seminars in the mornings, or you can explore the area, or use any of the facilities in the hotel. Non-playing partners are most welcome, but will have to arrange their own evening entertainment.

Cancellation Policy

Places are offered on a 'first-come, first-served' basis, and rooms allocated accordingly.

If you change your mind before 31st October 2016, you will receive a full refund of any monies paid.

If you change your mind after 31st October, but before 31st December 2016, you will receive a refund of any monies paid except the deposit (£75/105).

After 31st December 2016, no refunds will be given unless the place can be re-sold. If your place is re-sold, then you will receive a refund of £175/£205 in total.

The Club does not undertake to try to re-sell the place on your behalf. If the break is not fully-booked, new bookings will not be used to refund your place. You are advised to try to re-sell it yourself.

This Bridge Break will be offered in the first instance to members of Newent Bridge Club and their friends, including those who have attended previously. **Minimum number is 30 paying guests, maximum is 55 (depending on coach seating capacity).**
