West has Q7, South leads J, Should west play Q??? [Ans - yes but why]

Example 3 - South is dummy

North South

AK3 JT84

West has Q7, South leads J, Should west play Q??? [Ans - no but why?]

SO - Is the rule always cover an honour with an honour -NO!!

[Ans - only when it promotes either partners or your own hand]
