## **Bank Holiday Monday and Teams**

We will be playing on Monday 6th May but there will not be a host. Because of the bank holiday the next teams will now be on **13th May.** 

#### Rules

Our club prides itself on being accessible and friendly but we do need to stick to the basic rules. We are playing a difficult game with complex rules and if people don't abide by even the simplest rules then they are unfairly disadvantaging their opponents

Here are two areas that have come up recently:

#### Convention cards.

Unless a pair are playing very basic system a convention card should be completed so that the opposition can inform themselves of the meaning of bids and also to help the director if necessary.

**Hesitation or 'playing with bidding box'**: bidding should be smooth as possible, accepting that some hands require a greater degree of thought. However, the bidding box should not be touched until a bid is ready to be made. During the auction a long pause for thought, followed by a pass is not automatically penalised, but if partner takes advantage of the unauthorised information provided by the hesitation then the director may be called and the offending pair penalised
