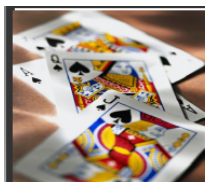

ALERT! ALERT! ALERT! From Anne Landry

DID YOU KNOW: When you cuebid your opponent's suit and you are promising that suit exactly, the cuebid must be alerted. For example, if your right hand opponent opens 1 diamond and you overcall 2 diamonds or 3 diamonds AND IF YOUR BID GUARANTEES A DIAMOND SUIT with the intention of playing in diamonds, then your partner must alert your bid. This is an exception to the generally held belief that "all cuebids are self-alerting."
