You will learn good hand evaluation in bidding your slams but equally important is to know how and when to stop just shy of a slam.

Lesson 2 – Strong 2♣ opener and responses Handling interference

Lesson 3 - How and when to bid controls. You have enough points to be in slam but hold a useless doubleton in your hand. Blackwood and 1430 may not tell you if partner holds the ace or king/queen but controls will. Controls are especially vital is getting to low point slams and staying out of a slam.
