Built as a hotel in 1872, the Metropole now serves as a major conference centre for the Mid Wales area. It is the largest privately owned hotel in Wales and is easily accessible on the A483 from the M4, M5, M56, M54 and M42.

It has 120 en-suite bedrooms and suites. The leisure centre has an 18 metre heated swimming pool and the gym contains the latest aerobic and cardiovascular equipment.
