"ADVANCED LEARNER CLASSES"

Suitable for Club players and those who have completed the SBU course

For 10 weeks on Friday afternoons, beginning 20th January 2017, the Melville Bridge Academy's Ian Crorie and Lucia Barrett will offer a course of teaching and play which extends the SBU learners' course and gives you further essential tools of the game! The theme is 'Defence & Other Stuff', and the course comprises teaching weeks, interspersed with sessions of play designed to reinforce the topics being taught. This is Module 4 (of 4) in the A.L. course.

- ➤ **Week 1** 20th January '**Our System of Defence'**. Revising our existing system of signals (attitude & count) and rules/guidelines on opening leads.
- ➤ Week 2 27th January 'Defend with me' & Play session, covering Week 1 topics.
- ➤ **Week 3** 3rd February **'More on Counting'**. Count signals on subsequent rounds (remaining count), Rule of 11, Active v. Passive defences.
- ➤ Week 4 10th February 'Defend with me' & Play session, covering Week 3 topics.
- ➤ **Week 5** 17th February -'**More topics on Defence**'. When to consider leading trumps, declarer's disguise & deception, playing a Queen under partner's Ace.
- ➤ Week 6 24th February 'Defend with me' & Play session, covering Week 5 topics.
- ➤ **Week 7** 3rd March **'Matchpoint Strategy & Tactics'**. How this common form of scoring a tournament affects the way we should approach bidding, play & defence.
- ➤ **Week 8** 10th March **Play session** covering Week 7 topics, and a brief talk on 'Bridge Etiquette 1' Using the Bidding Box and Explanations to Opponents.
- ➤ Week 9 17th March 'Roman Key-Card Blackwood'. A modern slam-bidding convention, improving on the traditional Blackwood 4NT.
- ➤ **Week 10** 24th March **Play session** covering Week 9 topics, and a brief talk on 'Bridge Etiquette 2' When things go wrong at the table and bridge ethics.

All sessions are from 2 to 4pm on Fridays. Please note that the course is a full package, and costs £50 for the 10 weeks – a real bargain! Places are limited to 36.
