New Melville Bridge Club Tournament Details

The Calvert Cup is a pairs championship played over six evenings from April to September with the best three percentage scores to count. In addition the pair with the single highest score (excluding the winners of the Calvert Cup) is awarded the Hamilton Cup.

The Pinkhill Pairs is a Bronze pairs championship played alongside the Calvert Cup over six evenings with the best three scores counting. Scoring will be by Cross-IMPs and you receive championship points based upon your position in the field and the number of pairs.

The Freddie Short Cup and McGregor Salver will be a Swiss teams event run over two successive Wednesdays. The highest placed team wins the Freddie Short Cup and the highest placed Bronze team wins the McGregor Salver.

The Purves Clock will be a randomly drawn mixed Bronze/ Silver/Gold Teams event this year played for over two evenings.

The Grosvenor and Pinkhill Pivot Teams Trophies and Shields will be run as Swiss events (4 x 6-board matches) subject to sufficient numbers. Both events take place over a single evening.

The Manson Cup is the Melville Teams Championship event with the **Westchester Shield** being a consolation event for those who fail to qualify for the final. Players enter as teams of four, five or six and play teams over the two qualifying nights. The top four teams qualify for the Manson Cup finals.

The Westchester Mixed Pairs Championship is a two session championship. Pairs that enter <u>must</u> be committed to playing in the second session as the scores from both sessions will be combined to determine an overall winner.

The Ronaldson Bowl will be a handicapped multiple teams championship played for over two nights. Teams can consist of up to six players. Scoring will be by IMPs. Bronze teams have a +10 IMP handicap against Gold teams and a +5 IMP handicap against Silver teams. Silver teams have a +5 IMP handicap against Gold Teams.

The Accumulator is a handicapped pairs competition played for over the summer months. Players can have two counting scores with any one partner and for every player their best six results count. The scale of handicaps, which is based upon SBU rankings, will be published prior to the competition.

Rules and Bye-laws

- The categories of membership are Full, Honorary, Country, Junior and Associate.
- Associate members are currently enrolled members in the Melville Bridge Academy.
- Full and Honorary Members have voting rights and may attend the Annual General meeting or any Extraordinary General meetings that may be convened.
- Country Members are members who live more than 25 miles from the New Melville Bridge Club.
- Members must enter the names of visitors in the Visitors' Book.
- Players must take their seats at least ten minutes before the start of play.
- In exceptional circumstances late arrivals will be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director/ Scorer provided it does not cause too much disruption at the start of play.
- Members are required to exhibit correct behaviour to fellow users of the club at all times. This shall include acting with courtesy and consideration at the bridge table and in the social area.

Opening & Closing Times

The club will be open from midday on Mondays and Thursdays, 13.30 on Wednesdays and from 18.15 on Tuesdays and Fridays. Weekend opening times will depend on the tournament being played.

The club will close at 22.30, or later, at the Club Manager's discretion.

<u>Please note:</u> With the exception of the two-day congress, the club will be closed between Christmas and New Year, reopening on Tuesday 2 January for an evening tournament, if there is sufficient interest. See website calendar nearer the time for confirmation.
