


Squeeze card, 2 Threat cards, Rectified Count




Squeeze Play Basics What is a Squeeze Play?


- * Technique to develop exactly ONE trick
- * Cash winners in such a way that the defense MUST discard their guard cards
- Successful if only ONE defender holds both of TWO potential winners AND must discard one of them
- * If the potential winners are split between defenders, there is no possible squeeze













When South leads the $\mathbf{\Phi} \mathbf{x}$, West is squeezed and discard one of his winners, making $7 \mathbf{\Phi}$





★ Play: ♣ruff, ♠AKQJ, ♥KJAQ, no squeeze!

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
