Your bid is $3 a$ which is forcing.
Partner will now decide where to play.

\& Q 7
Here you have a six card spade suit and 14 points.
You bid 4a.

Hand E:
1NT-(2v)-?
A K Q 965
-K 3

- 874
\& K 75
We have 11 points and a five card spade suit.
Our initial bid is 2NT.
Partner bids 3\&
We now bid 3a (invitational)
Partner makes the final decision.

Bidding has gone 1NT - (2 A ), you hold

-K 3

You bid 2NT (Lebensohl)
Partner bids 3\%

## Hand G:

Bidding has gone 1NT-2A, you hold

- 84
\& Q 63

Difficult decision.
Over $2 *$ or $2 \vee$, we would have bid $2 \vee$.
Over $2 \boldsymbol{A}$, it is probably best to pass

Hand H :
Bidding has gone 1NT - (2A), you hold
A 85

- KQ9874
- 84
\& Q 63
Similar hand to $G$, but this time you have 6 hearts.
Bid 2NT, and over the forced $3 *$, bid $3 \vee$.

Hand I:
Bidding has gone 1NT - (2A), you hold
A 85
-KQ974

- K 84
* AQ6

You have 13 points and a good five card heart suit.

Bid a forcing $3 v$ and let partner decide the final contract.

Hand J:
Bidding has gone 1NT - (2A), you hold

- 852
- KQ97
- K 84
* A Q 6

You have 14 points and a four card heart suit and no stopper in spades.
The initial bid is $3 \boldsymbol{A}$, showing a game going hand with four hearts and no stopper in spades.

Hand K:
Bidding has gone 1NT - (2 $\uparrow$ ), you hold
A A 52

- KQ9 7
-K 84
- J 76

You have 13 points and a four card heart suit and a stopper in spades.
Your initial bid is 2NT.
Partner bids 3\&.
You then bid 3A.
This tells partner you have a game going hand, four hearts and a stopper in spades.

Hand L:
Bidding has gone 1NT - (2A), you hold
A 852

- KJ 9
- K 84
\& AK 76
You have 14 points, no stopper in spades, and only a three card heart suit.
Your initial bid is 3NT.
Partner then decides on the best contract, which might be four of a minor.

Hand $M$ :
Bidding has gone 1NT - (2A), you hold
A AJ5

- J 93
-K 84
\& A 976
You have 13 points, a stopper in spades, and only a three card heart suit.
Your initial bid is 2NT.
Partner bids 3\&.
You now bid 3NT, showing a stopper in spades and enough points for game.
