# OPENER'S REBID AFTER LEBENSOHL SEQUENCE

#### Example 1: You hold the following hand

- **♦** K J 3 2
- **∀**KJ6
- ♦ 10 8 6
- 🗚 Q 3

and the bidding has gone

What do you bid?

Partner has denied four spades and a heart stopper, but has 13+ points.

You pass.

#### Example 2: You hold the following hand

- ♠ K J 3 2
- **∀**KJ6
- 10 8 6
- 🗚 Q 3

and the bidding has gone

What do you bid?

Partner has shown four spades and denied a heart stopper, and has 13+ points.

You bid 4♠.

## Example 3: You hold the following hand **▲** K J 3 2 **∀**K J 6 +1086♣ A Q 3 and the bidding has gone $1NT - (2 \lor) - 2NT - (pass) - ?$ What do you bid? Partner has instructed you to bid 3 ♣ You therefore bid $3 \clubsuit$ .

Example 4: You hold the following hand ▲ K J 3 **∀**KJ6 ♦ 10 8 6 2 ♣ A Q 3 and the bidding has gone  $1NT - (2 \lor) - 3 \lor - (pass) - ?$ What do you bid?

Partner has shown four spades and denied a heart stopper, and has 13+ points.

You bid 3NT as you have a heart stopper and only 3 spades.

Example 5: You hold the following hand **♦** K J 3 **V**KJ6 ♦ 10 8 6 2 ♣ A Q 3 and the bidding has gone  $1NT - (2 \lor) - 2 \spadesuit - (pass) - ?$ What do you bid? Partner has shown a weak hand with at least five spades.

You pass.

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Example 6: You hold the following hand
▲ K J 3
VKJ6
10 8 6 2
♣ A Q 3
and the bidding has gone
1NT - (2 \lor) - 2NT - (pass) - 3 \clubsuit - (pass) - 3 \bigstar - (pass)
- ?
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What do you bid?

Partner has shown a hand with at least five spades and 11-12 points.

You bid 4♠.

Example 7: You hold the following hand **▲** K 3 **∀**KQ6 10862 ♣ A Q 3 2 and the bidding has gone  $1NT - (2 \lor) - 2NT - (pass) - 3 \clubsuit - (pass) - 3 \bigstar - (pass) - ?$ What do you bid? Partner has shown a hand with at least five spades and 11-12 points.

You bid 3NT, as you have maximum points but only two spades.

Example 8: You hold the following hand **▲** K 3 2 **∀**K 7 6 ♦ 10 8 6 2 ♣ A Q 3 and the bidding has gone  $1NT - (2 \lor) - 2NT - (pass) - 3 \clubsuit - (pass) - 3 \bigstar - (pass) - ?$ What do you bid? Partner has shown a hand with at least five spades and

11-12 points.

You pass, as you have minimum points.

Example 9: You hold the following hand **▲** K 3 2 **V** K 7 6 ♦ 10 8 6 2 ♣ A Q 3 and the bidding has gone 1NT – (2♥) – 3♠ - ? What do you bid? Partner has shown a hand with at least five spades and 13+ points.

With three card support you bid  $4 \clubsuit$ .

### Example 10: You hold the following hand **▲** K 3 **V** K J 7 6 10862 ♣ A Q 3 and the bidding has gone 1NT – (2♥) – 3♠ - ? What do you bid?

Partner has shown a hand with exactly five spades and 13+ points.

With only two card support and the hearts stopped you bid 3NT.

The hands considered so far have been chosen such that opener's rebid is fairly obvious.

We now consider a few hands where the rebid is not obvious.

Example 11: You hold the following hand **▲** K 3 **976** ♦ A J 8 6 ♣ A Q 3 2 and the bidding has gone 1NT - (2♥) - 3♠ - ? What do you bid?

Partner has shown a hand with exactly five spades and 13+ points.

Example 12: You hold the following hand **▲** J 3 **976** • A J 8 6 ♣ A Q 3 2 and the bidding has gone 1NT – (2♥) – 3NT - ? What do you bid?

Partner has shown a hand without a heart stopper and without four spades and 13+ points.
